WHEREAS: Principals set the academic tone for their schools and work collaboratively with teachers to develop mission statements, maintain high curriculum standards, and set performance goals and objectives for schools to achieve educational excellence; and

WHEREAS: Minnesota recognizes outstanding elementary, middle, and high school principals who have succeeded in providing high-quality learning opportunities for students in public, private, and tribal schools, as well as their exemplary contributions to the profession; and

WHEREAS: Minnesota honors the contributions of all school principals and assistant principals at all grade levels in ensuring that every child has access to a high-quality education and the opportunity to succeed.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, TIM WALZ, Governor of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim October 1 – 7, 2024 as:
